US Position: September 2024

- 1. Leverage demand side and supply side measures within their applicable legal authorities with an aim to reduce plastic pollution, consumption, and waste to make meaningful progress tackling the plastic pollution crisis
- 2. A global goal to reduce the global production and consumption of primary plastic polymers should serve as an effective goal -a north star to encourage continued and meaningful ambitious ambition for all countries.
- 3. Global criteria and lists may be useful tools to address problematic and avoidable plastic products as well as the use of chemicals of concern within plastic products together with a range of options for countries with respect to these chemicals and products.
