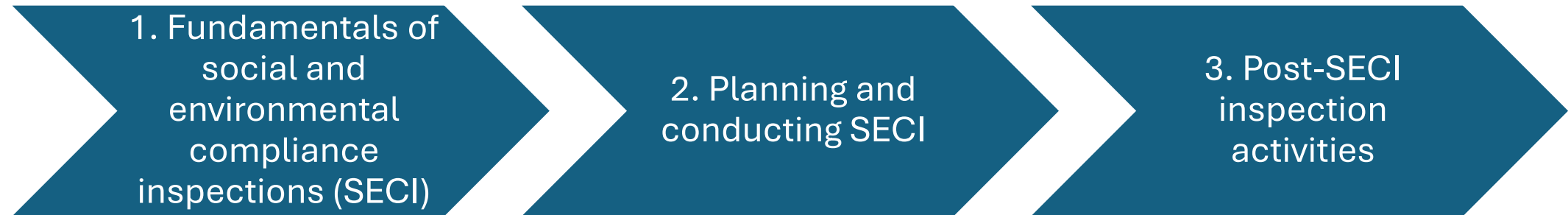

# 3. Course learning objectives

1. Identify the principles, roles, and responsibilities required for environmental and social inspection according to international good practices.
2. Explain why environmental and social compliance inspections are necessary to ensure regulation and law enforcement.
3. Manage resources efficiently through targeted compliance promotion, compliance monitoring, inspections, and enforcement activities.
4. Identify the inspection functions necessary to effectively manage environmental and social risks and impacts and the appropriate responses to violations.
5. Identify the elements of an enforceable requirement.
6. Select inspection and monitoring activities to ensure compliance within a regulatory framework.
7. Identify ways in which to collect, document, and present evidence, including samples, in a legally defensible manner.
