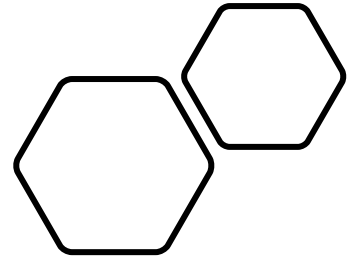

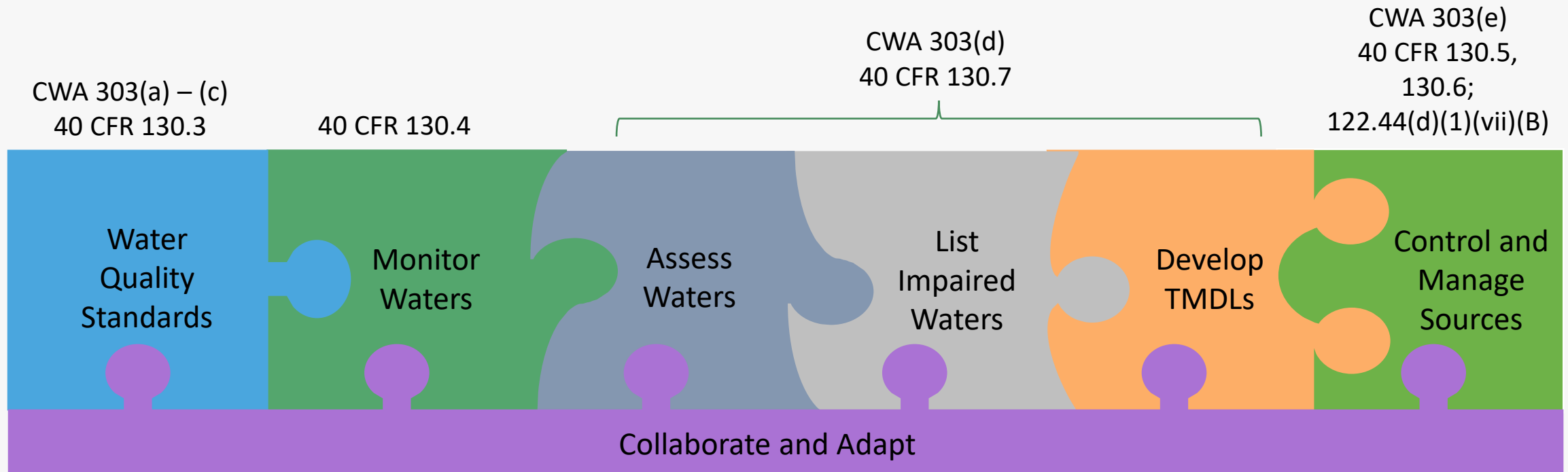

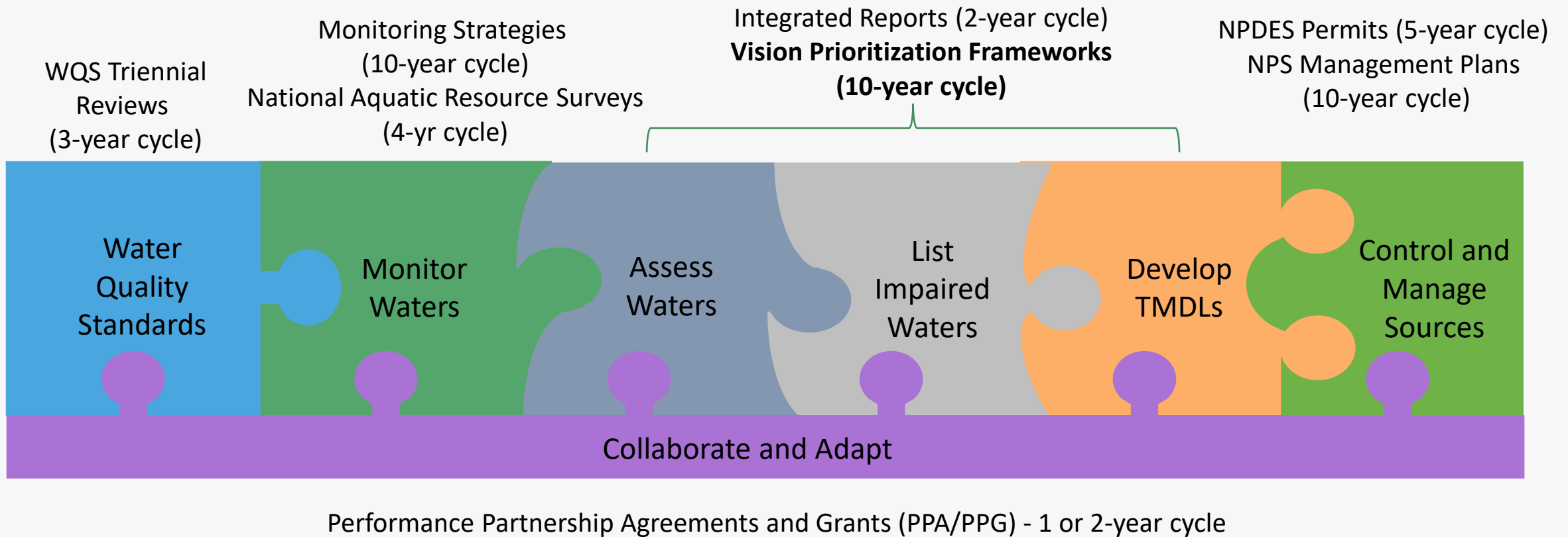


Clean Water Act - Background
